Indra Nooyi most powerful women in US business: Fortune

FOR the third year in a row, India-born chief executive of Pepsico Indra Nooyi has been named as the most powerful women in the US business in the annual list prepared by American publication Fortune.

In the 11th annual list of 50 most powerful women in business, Nooyi is followed by food maker Kraft Foods' chief executive and chairman Irene Rosenfeld and leading grain processor Archer Daniels Midland's chief executive Pat Woertz, at the second and third positions, respectively.

Writing on Nooyi, the

magazine said that Nooyi has moved swiftly to offset slowing beverages sales in North America by expanding the global business, which accounts for about 26% of the company's revenues.
